School Dress Code

The school dress code stipulates what is an acceptable appearance for children at school. This assists in creating a sense of school community, promoting pride in our school and ensuring that every student feels a sense of belonging. Students in uniform are readily identifiable and this greatly increases security and safety.

The school expects that all students will adhere to the dress code. Students who consistently arrive at school in clothing or appearance that does not meet the dress code will be directed to the office. If the clothing is inappropriate, students will be provided with appropriate clothing to change into for the day. Should the concern be with make-up or accessories, the student will be asked to remove the make-up or accessories and return to class. Repeated violations of the dress code will be referred to the parents in a letter from the Principal.

School Uniform

Navy Blue lower body and Ocean Blue upper body. Faction colours ((RED, GREEN, GOLD, BLUE) – for sports only.

Upper Body

GPS polo shirts / plain polo shirts, long or short sleeves – OCEAN BLUE.
School endorsed Year 6 shirts
Faction colours- sports only
GPS windcheater (crew neck or zip) – NAVY
Polar fleece vest – NAVY
GPS Hoodie – Navy
Jacket – NAVY (preferably water proof)
Dress – summer checked

Lower Body

Shorts – cargo, long leg, rugby knit (unisex), taslon sport shorts-NAVY
Skorts – NAVY
Skirts – modest length, sport, long line – NAVY
Track pants – NAVY
Leggings – NAVY
Long trousers – NAVY

Accessories

Wearing eye make-up, lipstick or blush is not permitted. Visible jewellery is not permitted with the exception of watches and small sleepers or ear studs. Any accessories that may potentially cause injury must be removed prior to participating in sport.

Hats

Navy broad brimmed hats must be worn for all outside activities all year round. Baseball style caps and visors do not give sufficient protection from the sun and are **not** acceptable as hats. Children not wearing a broad brim hat will not be permitted to play outside or participate in sports.

Footwear

Should be flat shoes which are fully enclosed and are in good condition. Sandals are acceptable in summer, provided safety is not compromised. Footwear will be worn at all times.

Unacceptable clothing

Denim is not to be worn at any time. Clothing which allows the midriff to be seen is unacceptable. Slip on footwear, such as thongs are not acceptable. Very short shorts, short skirts/dresses, and clothing with logos are not appropriate as school wear.

Students who do not meet the dress code will not be permitted to attend school excursions, functions or participate in interschool events.
